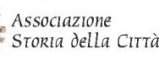

The DRUM (Dynamic Research on Urban Morphology) research group and laboratory focuses on the diachronical aspects of urban and territorial transformations, looking at the history of the built environment as well as designing its future; it welcomes the expertise of Architects, Interior Designers, Urban Planners, and Urban Morphologists and does include broad interdisciplinary cooperation with other disciplines such as Geography, History and Archaeology. The research group aims to describe the dynamics of urban growth in different morphological and geographical settings by comparing a number of relevant case studies in capital cities as well as small towns, with the intention of driving a shift of opinion to the latter. The research group applies the comparative method and other analytical tools, such as GIS, Space Syntax, Typological plans, Typological process, Muratorian, Caniggian and Conzenian analysis at different scales and within different chronological phases to understand the past and above all, to design the future of large cities and small towns.

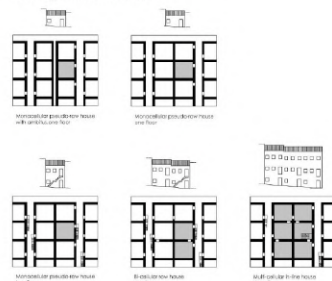
